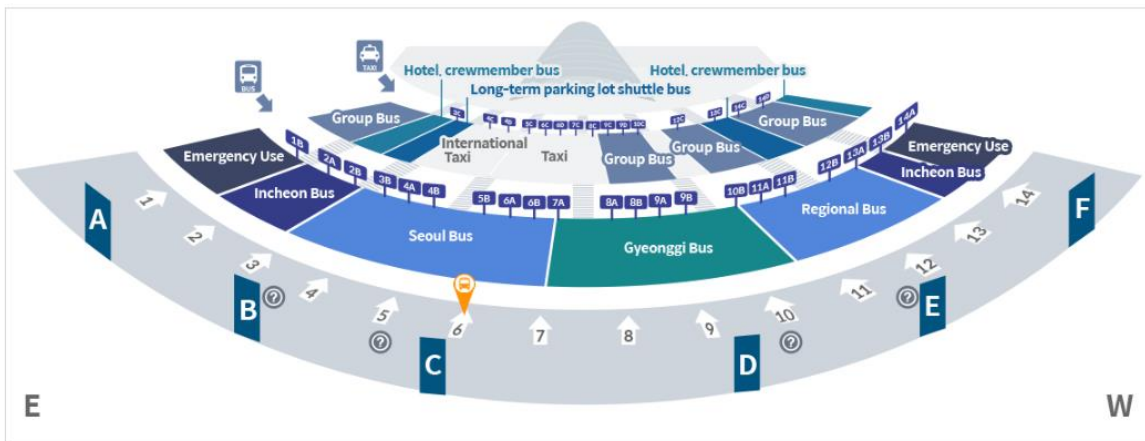

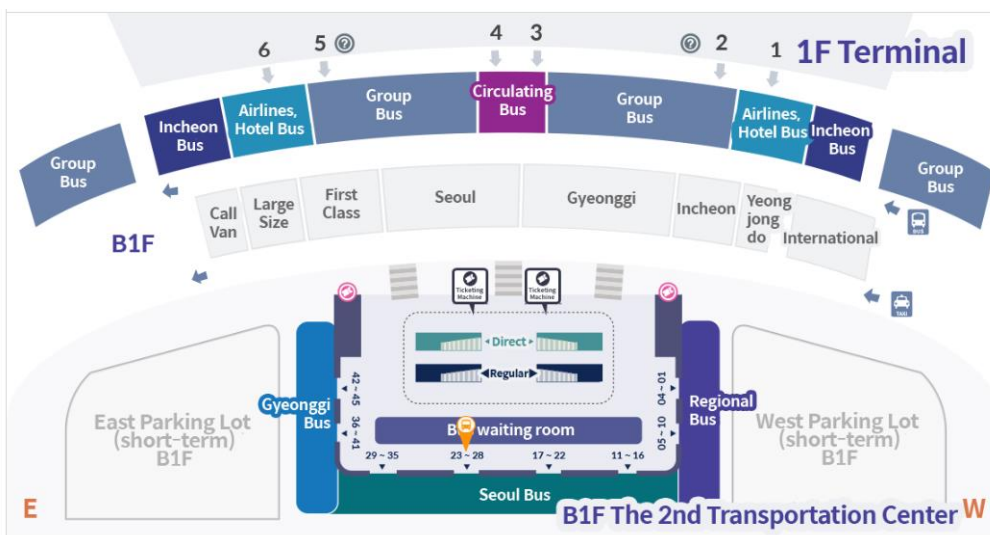
Route information

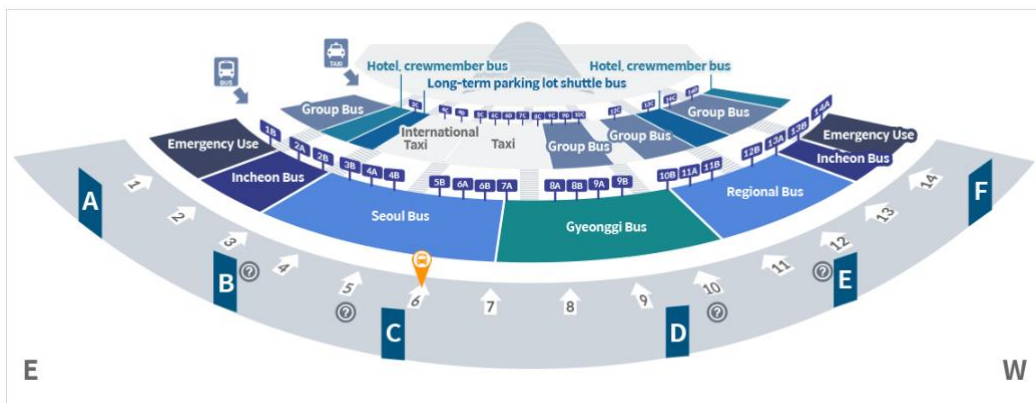

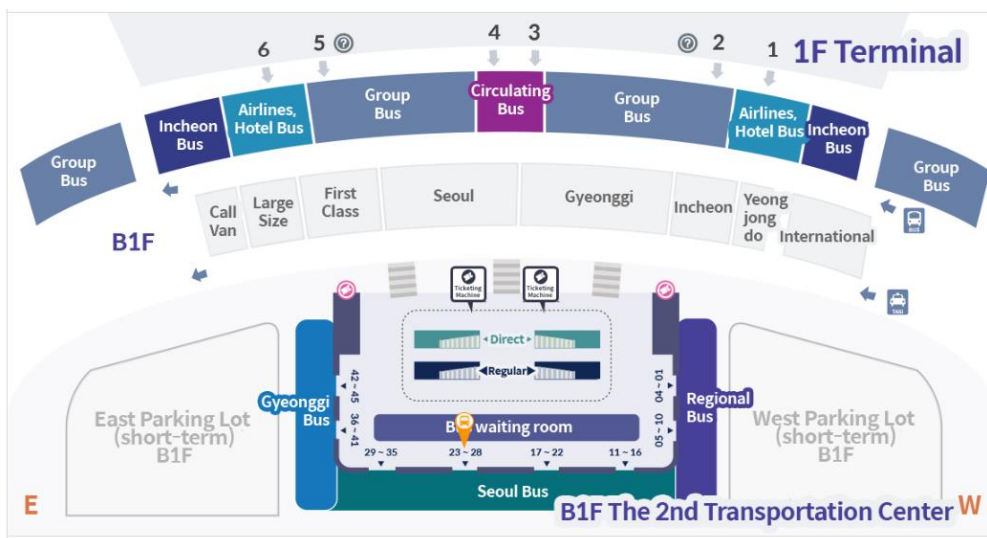
Route information

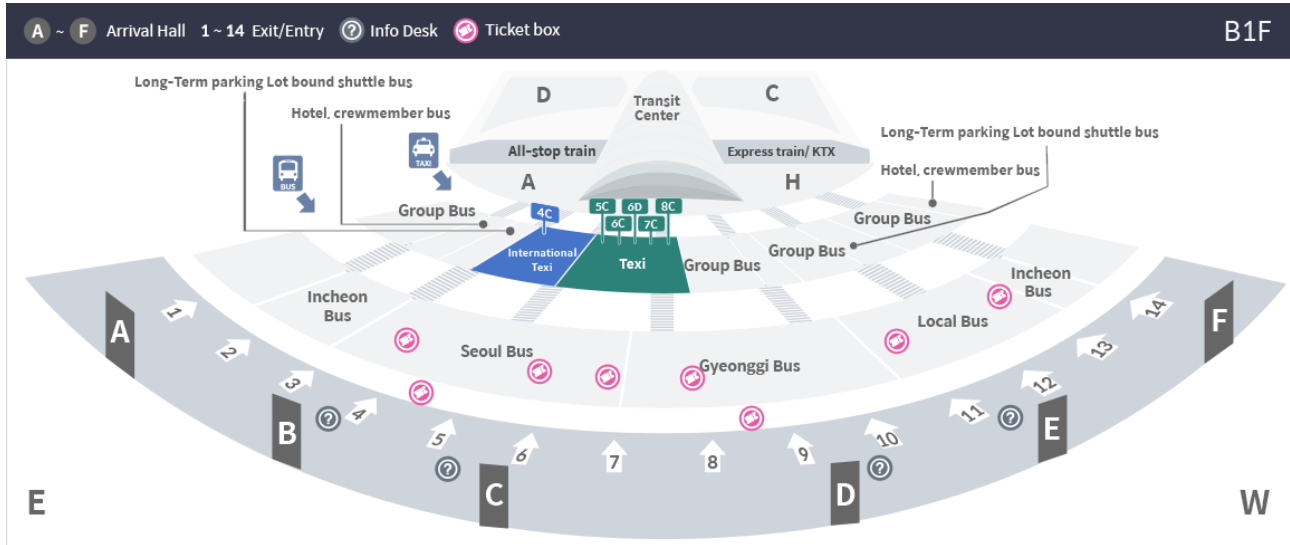

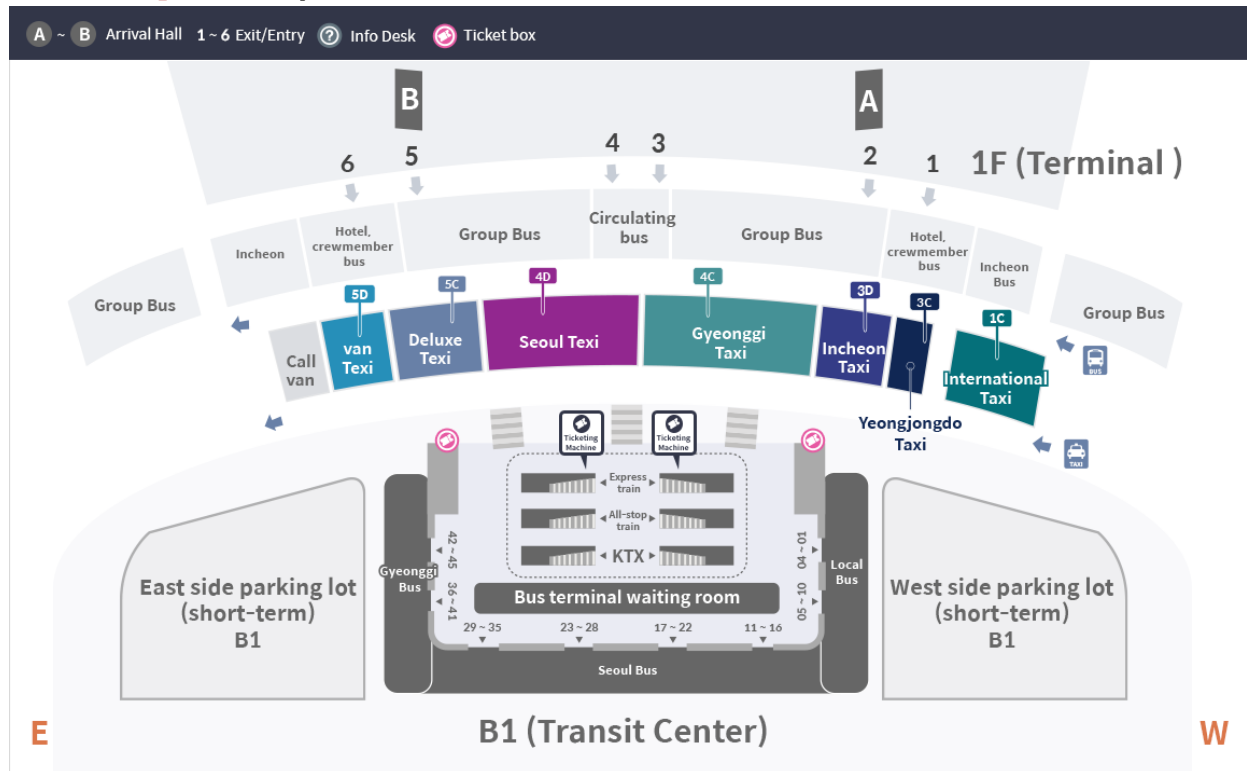

[Terminal 1] Taxi stop locations



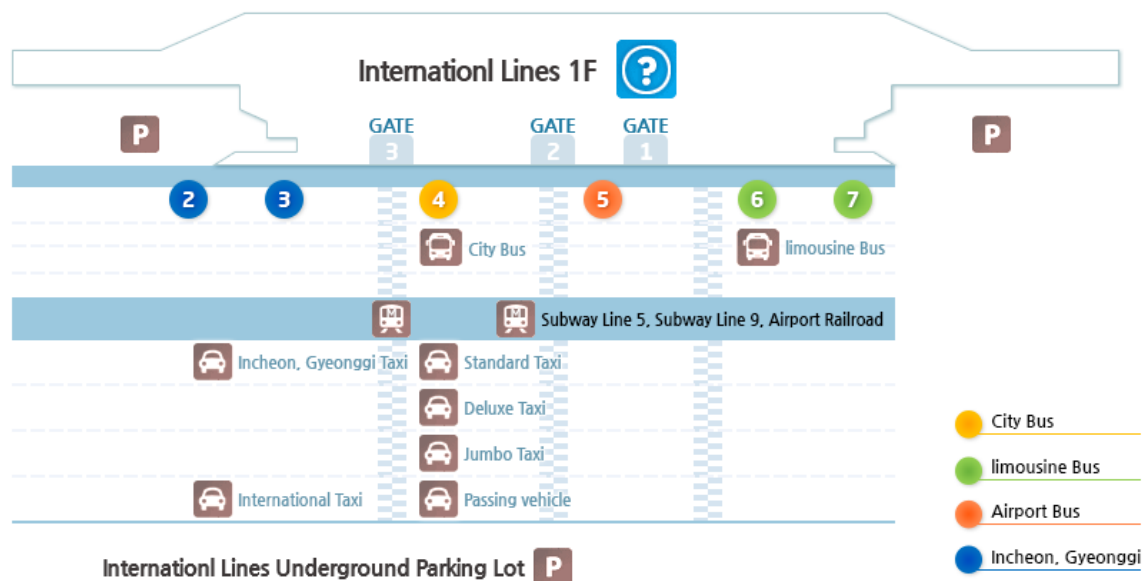
[Terminal 2] Taxi stop locations

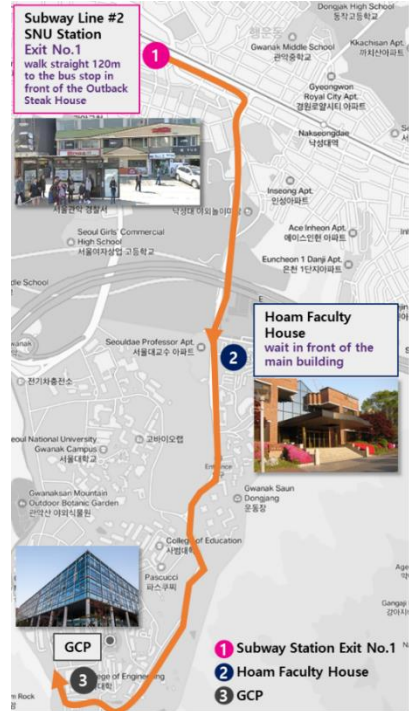

* The shuttle bus schedule is subject to changes caused by weather and traffic conditions.

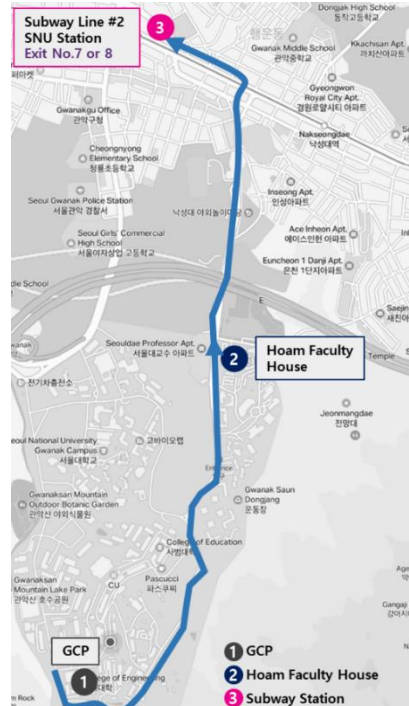

■ **Time Zone:** Korea is located in Greenwich Mean Time +9

■ **Money**

Korea's currency is the won (KRW or ₩). There are 1,000; 5,000; 10,000; and 50,000 won bills. Coins come in 10, 100, and 500 won. For more details, please visit below website.

When you need to exchange your foreign currency into Korean won, visit a bank, exchange service center, or an authorized exchange. Bank business hours: 09:00-16:00 (closed on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays).

■ **Credit Card & ATMs**

Visa, American Express, Diners Club, Master Card and other major credit cards are accepted in Korea. Cash withdrawal is also available at select bank machines. Cards with the Plus and Cirrus logos are the easiest to use and most widely accepted in Korea. Some ATMs accept most major international bank cards, such as Maestro, Citibank, Citi card, Electron, JCB and others. Most ATM/bank machines operate 24 hours a day, while others are open from 8am to midnight.

■ **Public Transportation (in Seoul)**

Seoul has an extensive network of public transportation and taxis. Consistently voted as one of the best in the world for its ease of use, cleanliness, and frequency of service, the Seoul subway system is one of the most efficient ways to travel around the city. Trains run non-stop from approximately 5:30 am until midnight. All subway lines are color coded and stations display signs in Korean, English, and Chinese.

Subway | KRW 1,350 basic fare (Discounts given only to those residing in Korea who use T-money)

Taxi | KRW 3,800 basic fare (Taxi is charged by the meter and the drivers do NOT expect a tip)

Public Bus | KRW 1,300 basic fare (local), KRW 2,400 basic fare (express)

* Additional charges apply by car mileage and running time.



With a T-money card (https://english.visitkorea.or.kr/enu/TRP/TP_ENG_8_1_1.jsp), available at most convenience stores (including those at the airports), you can use bus, subway and taxi anywhere in Seoul and Korea at discounted rates. This means, you do not need to purchase tickets each time or carry cash and coins. Just deposit enough cash value in the card when you purchase, and tag the “beeping” devices with your card when you get on and off. When you leave Korea, you can get the refund of the remaining deposit at any convenience stores (or keep it to re-use when you visit Korea next time).

■ Electricity and Voltage



The standard voltage in Korea is 220 volts. The outlet has two round holes and is the same type used in France, Germany, Austria, Greece, Turkey, and many other countries. If you do not have a multi-voltage travel adapter, you can borrow one from your hotel's front desk. Please note that the welcome package given to every ICASP13 participant includes a free voltage adaptor. If you still need to buy one in Korea, you can do so at a duty-free shop or convenience stores at Incheon International Airport.

■ Mobile Phones

Mobile phones can be rented from major telecom companies such as LG, SK, and KT in the arrivals lobby at Incheon and Gimpo International Airports. To rent a phone, you will need to provide your passport and a credit card. Your rental phone must be returned to the same counter from which it was rented.

Prepaid SIM cards can be purchased at convenience stores, bookstore and transportation center at the Airport.

■ Safety

Whether you are traveling as a group or as a solo female traveler, you can rest assured that Seoul is a safe place to visit. As long as basic safety precautions are taken, there should not be any problems that may hinder your experiences in Seoul.

Follow basic safety rules - most parts of Seoul are safe to freely roam around day and night, even for women traveling alone. As long as basic safety precautions are taken, like avoiding dark alleys and parking lots, it is very unlikely to encounter dubious or troublesome individuals. In the event you encounter police in full riot gear, do not be alarmed. In most cases, the riot police are there as a precaution. Simply, keep out of the way of any confrontations that may occur.

In the event of an incident, go to the nearest police station or dial 112. If you are a victim of an assault or an infraction, day or night, go to the nearest police station to file a report.
